The “Air Force One” call sign was created after a 1953 incident, during which a plane carrying President Dwight Eisenhower entered the same airspace as a commercial airline flight using the same flight number. “Air Force One” is one of the most famous aircraft to ever fly our skies and is known throughout the world.
